3. Expense tracker

Tips:

- Build **reusable components**
 - Learn to **fetch and display data dynamically**

Month 3: Full-Stack Integration & Portfolio

Skills to Learn

- Node.js + Express basics (optional, for full-stack knowledge)
- REST API integration
- Deployment: Netlify, Vercel

Mini Projects

1. Full-stack To-Do app
2. Simple blog with CRUD operations
3. Personal portfolio website with deployed projects

Tips:

- Deploy all projects online
 - Add **README.md** and live links to GitHub
 - Share portfolio on LinkedIn or developer communities

Key Practices Throughout the 3 Months

- **Daily Coding:** 1–2 hours of focused practice
- **Mini Projects:** Apply every new skill immediately
- **Version Control:** Use Git/GitHub from day 1
- **Problem Solving:** Solve beginner DSA problems alongside projects

- **Documentation:** Every project should have README + screenshots

Key Takeaways

- Structured learning beats random tutorials
 - Start simple → build complexity gradually → deploy
 - Portfolio + GitHub + live projects = recruiter-ready
 - Consistency over intensity: small daily progress compounds
