 - **Tech Stack:** React, Node.js/Express, WebSockets (Socket.io)
 - **Takeaway:** Real-time updates, backend event handling

Project 7: E-Commerce Store

- **Goal:** Product listing, cart, checkout, and payment simulation
 - **Tech Stack:** React, Node.js/Express, MongoDB
 - **Takeaway:** Complex full-stack project, demonstrates practical skills

Project 8: Notes App with Authentication

- **Goal:** Users can create, edit, delete notes after login
 - **Tech Stack:** React, Node.js/Express, JWT, MongoDB
 - **Takeaway:** Authentication + CRUD + secure data handling

Project 9: Portfolio Website with Blog Section

- **Goal:** Personal portfolio + project showcase + blog posts
 - **Tech Stack:** React, Node.js backend for blog posts
 - **Takeaway:** Combines personal branding with full-stack skills

 - Deploy projects online and link in portfolio
 - Write clear **README.md** with features, tech stack, and screenshots
 - Test thoroughly and fix bugs
